**Gary D. Norsworthy, DVM**, has been in private practice for 40 years, 25 in small animal practice and 15 in feline practice. He is the owner of Alamo Feline Health Center in San Antonio, Texas. In addition to practice, he lectures frequently on feline diseases and is the editor and major author of 6 feline textbooks, the most recent being ***The Feline Patient, 4th Edition*** and ***Nursing The Feline Patient***, the first American feline textbook for technicians. He is a charter Diplomat of the American Board of Veterinary Practitioners in the Feline Practice Category and an Adjunct Professor at the College of Veterinary Medicine, Mississippi State and Western University. He was chosen for the 2009 Practitioner of the Year Award in the Medical Specialist category by the TVMA.
