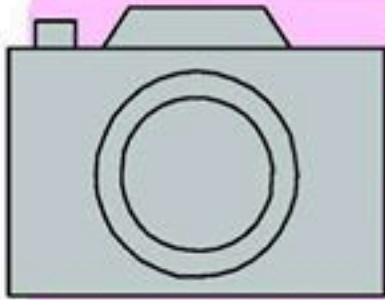


4-H Clover Project Meeting – Photography
