#### Vegetables & Herbs

**Celebrity Tomato**—\$4 per 4-pack. This variety bears medium to large, meaty fruit with exceptional flavor from midsummer to frost.

**Tomato Medley**—\$4 per 4-pack. Enjoy a collection of 3 different varieties.

**Early Girl**: Two plants included of this early maturing tomato that grows to 36" with compact habit and heavy fruiting.

**Indigo Blue Beauty**: One plant included of this exotic heirloom hybrid which produces a meaty beefsteak fruit with dark shoulders and excellent flavor.

**Candyland**: One plant included of this early maturing variety that is a heavy producer of very sweet 0.5" fruit—a cherry tomato lover's favorite!!

**Mucho Nacho Jalapeno**—\$4 per 4-pack. This variety is wonderful producer of large 4" fruit that is well-suited for grilling and salsas. Matures midsummer and produces until frost.

**Sequoia Poblano**—\$4 per 4-pack. This early maturing variety of ancho/poblano pepper has large fruit with a mild to medium flavor.

**Banana Pepper**—\$4 per 4-pack. Pepper variety with large 6" yellow fruit with sweet flesh that is well suited for eating raw, frying, or pickling.

**Ace Bell**—\$4 per 4-pack. This early maturing variety consistently produces a mild, sweet fleshed 3-4 lobed fruit.

**Rosemary Barbecue**—\$3. An evergreen perennial that produces a remarkable flavor for cooking. Strong, straight stems make excellent barbecue skewers.

**Sweet Basil**—\$3. A warm season variety that is perfect for culinary use.

**Golden Edge Thyme**—\$3. A warm season variety with both lemon flavor and scent best used for cooking and teas.

#### Annuals

**Coleus**—*Sunglow Pink, Sangria, or Bonnie Gold*—Wonderful, upright plants that grow in sun and partial shade. Brightly painted foliage will compliment any container or border.

**Calibrachoa**—*Purple Cow, Royal Purple, or Cherry Crush*—Heavily flowering plant with a bushy, trailing habit similar to a petunia. These plants are perfect for hanging baskets and containers.

**Lantana**—*Miss Huff*—Upright plant with long blooming flowers that can be grown in the landscape or as a container plant.

**Sweet Potato Vine**—*Blackie, Margie*—Beautiful trailing foliage can be grown as a ground cover in borders or an accent plant in containers.

**Swedish Ivy**—Lush, variegated variety will thrive in summer heat when flowers are scarce.

**Verbena**—*Off With Her Red, Carolina Watermelon*—Profuse flowers will add color to containers from spring to fall.
