- When do clubs meet?

The WCOE offers three clubs. Even though they meet at different times, each club offers the same activities and curriculum.

October Clubs

Club members only register to attend one club.

- ✓ Raider Reds (Tuesdays, 4:30 pm – 5:30 pm)
- ✓ Masked Riders (Saturdays, 10:00 am – 11:00 am)
- ✓ Fearless Champions (Saturdays, 2:00 pm – 3:00 pm)

Clubs begin meeting in October and will meet throughout the month. Club meetings conclude the last week of October.

- Do clubs meet in person or virtually?

Clubs will meet virtually via Zoom. After you register your child, you will receive a ZOOM link invitation for meetings.

- Are there any costs associated with club membership?

No, club membership and materials are offered for free. We have sponsors that support our mission to provide Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) learning opportunities for all children.

- What do club members do during meetings?

Weekly club meetings typically last about an hour. Each week members are given a different engineering challenge. They have all week to design, build, and test their solution. At the next meeting they get to share their solution to the challenge.

- Is it OK to assist with the solution if my child is struggling with the activity?

Absolutely! We encourage you to work with your child and join in the fun.

- After I register my child, how do we receive the materials for club meeting activities?

Club organizers will hold a drive through materials pick up event. Before clubs start, you will receive an invitation with a date, time, and location for the event. You will receive all of the materials at this time that your child will need for participation.
