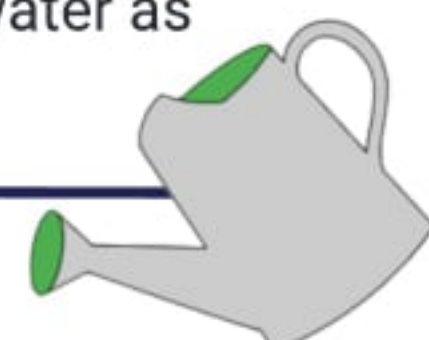
## Garden Maintenance



- Prune Fruit Trees
- Divide ornamental grasses
- Prune summer flowering shrubs
- Have cold frames or row covers handy to cover new seedlings and transplants
- Transplant seedlings to larger pots if needed

### WATER

- Water fall-seeded flowers and wild flowers in absence of rain
- Check seedlings daily
- maintain moderate moisture for herbs and cool-season vegetables
- Check annual flowers (pansies, violas, snap dragons, etc.) and water as needed



### CARE

- Fertilize winter annual flowers to keep them blooming
- Check cool-season crops for pests and treat as needed
- Pull young weeds
