6. SHADY LADY

Remarks: Set many fruits near ground on the plant. Use mulch. Resistant to verticillium wilt (V) and fusarium wilt (F).

75 Days - Determinate - 10oz
Trial Totals: 87 fruits 28.744 lbs.

7. BUSHY EARLY GIRL

Remarks: Very compact plant. First harvest 7/1. Resistant to verticillium wilt (V), nematodes, tobacco mosaic virus (TMV) and fusarium wilt (F).

72 Days - Determinate - 10oz
Trial Totals: 166 fruits 28.528 lbs.



8. PHOENIX

Remarks: Developed for Texas heat. Fruits ripen quickly 7-10 days and are crack resistant. Resistant to alternaria stem canker (Aal), gray leaf spot (Ss) and verticillium wilt (V).

72 Days - Determinate - 10-12oz
Trial Totals: 102 fruits 27.549 lbs.

9. JET STAR

Remarks: Low acid tomato with almost blemish free fruit. Resistant to verticillium wilt (V) and fusarium wilt (F).

72 Days - Indeterminate - 8-9oz
Trial Totals: 123 fruits 27.062 lbs.



10. CHEROKEE PURPLE

Remarks: Heirloom with beautiful colors. Let fruit fully ripen on the vine for best flavor.

90 Days - Indeterminate - 10-12oz
Trial Totals: 74 fruits 24.08 lbs.
