in a high tunnel*



11. ORANGE ZINGER

Remarks: Beautiful true orange crack resistant cherry tomato. Resistant to tomato mosaic virus (ToMV) and fusarium wilt (F). Agent favorite.

60 Days - Indeterminate - 1.5-2oz
Trial Totals: 948 fruits 21.764 lbs.

12. LA ROMA

Remarks: Excellent roma type known for sauce and canning. Resistant to tomato mosaic virus (ToMV), verticillium wilt (V) and fusarium wilt (F).

76 Days - Determinate - 5-8oz
Trial Totals: 151 fruits 21.269 lbs.



13. SUGAR RUSH

Remarks: Crunchy, dewdrop shaped grape tomato. Came down with late blight and was pulled early.

53 Days - Indeterminate - .5-1oz
Trial Totals: 1498 fruits 19.584 lbs.

14. LEMON BOY

Remarks: Bright yellow lemon color. Resistant to nematodes, alternaria stem canker (Aal), tobacco mosaic virus (TMV), gray leaf spot (Ss), tomato spotted wilt virus (TSWV), verticillium wilt (V) and fusarium wilt (F).

75 Days - Indeterminate - 7-8oz
Trial Totals: 110 fruits 18.451 lbs.



15. CHOCOLATE CHERRY

Remarks: Striking heirloom with cherry sized fruits that are brick red with deep chocolate shoulders. Agent favorite.

70 Days - Indeterminate - 1.5-2oz
Trial Totals: 819 fruits 18.437 lbs.
