16. MR. STRIPEY

Remarks: Huge heirloom beefsteak that is marbled red to yellow. Every fruit was blemished.
80 Days - Indeterminate - 14-48oz
Trial Totals: 30 fruits 17.822 lbs.

17. RED SNAPPER

Remarks: Versatile and adaptable. Resistant to alternaria stem canker (Aal), gray leaf spot (Ss), tomato spotted wilt virus (TSWV), verticillium wilt (V), tomato yellow leaf curl virus (TYLCV) and fusarium wilt (F).
75 Days - Determinate - 8-10oz
Trial Totals: 80 fruits 17.559 lbs.



18. SUNGOLD

Remarks: Very popular, firm cherry tomato with intense flavor. Fruits crack often. Resistant to tomato mosaic virus (ToMV) and fusarium wilt (F).
57 Days - Indeterminate - 1-2oz
Trial Totals: 1491 fruits 17.528 lbs.

19. CHAMPION

Remarks: Red tomato with a solid meaty texture. Resistant to verticillium wilt (V), nematodes, tobacco mosaic virus (TMV), tomato yellow leaf curl virus (TYLCV) and fusarium wilt (F).
65 Days - Indeterminate - 6-8oz
Trial Totals: 101 fruits 16.88 lbs.



20. CAMPARI

Remarks: Cocktail tomato, slightly larger than a cherry but smaller than a plum. Super flavorful. Grocery store quality appearance. Resistant to tobacco mosaic virus (TMV). Agent favorite.
80 Days - Indeterminate - 2-4oz
Trial Totals: 326 fruits 16.094 lbs.
