

Year. Enrollment will only be done through 4-H Online. Each 4-H'er who was enrolled for 2022-23 has a profile on 4-H Online. You will need to utilize last years profile to reenroll for 2023-24. Cost is \$25 for August 15 - October 31; afterward it will be \$30 per member. You may begin new enrollment after **August 15.** New members will need to set up a 4-H profile, please contact Ronda if you need assistance. For 3<sup>rd</sup> graders - please wait until **September 1**; otherwise you will be categorized as a Clover.

If you plan to work at the 4-H Barnyard, you need to be enrolled on 4-H Online before the event.

Lamb, swine and goat projects must all be validated for 2024 shows. Ear tags can be ordered at the County Extension Office from now until the tag order deadline date and must be paid for at the time of the tag order. All lambs, barrow and goats must be validated for the Lubbock County Junior Livestock Show held in January 2024, as well as the major shows.

#### Lamb/Goat Program:

Anticipated Deadline to Order Ear Tags -

August 18, 2023



Cost - \$20.00 per animal Validation Dates - **October**, 2023

Procedure - Ear tag, nose print, tattoo, DNA Sample, and complete forms.

#### Swine Program:

Anticipated Deadline to Order Ear Tags - Approximately September 18, 2023

Cost - \$20.00 per barrow

Validation Dates - November, 2023

Procedure - Ear tag, identify ear notches, DNA sample, and complete forms.
